Activities Report No. 22 of the Military Administration for the Period from 1 September – December 1942

Measures against the Jews

The evacuation of Jews out of Belgium was brought to a temporary conclusion in the report period. In total, 16,882 Jews were evacuated from Belgium on 14 transport trains. In addition, great numbers of Jews are fleeing Belgium, a development that could not be prevented despite tighter border controls. The remaining Jews in the country are in hiding, meaning that the deportations planned for a later date will be very difficult to carry out. According to rough estimates, there are currently still 10,000 Jews, including those of Belgian nationality, in Belgium.
